Letter dated 22 April 2024 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to resolution [2725 \(2024\)](#), adopted on 8 March 2024, by which the Security Council decided to extend the mandate of the Panel of Experts on the Sudan until 12 March 2025 and requested me to take the necessary administrative measures to that effect.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that, after consulting with the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution [1591 \(2005\)](#) concerning the Sudan, I have appointed the following experts:

- Ms. Laura Victoria Bernal Moncada, armed groups (Colombia)
- Ms. Lourraine Eayrs, finance (South Africa)
- Mr. Andrei Kolmakov, regional issues (Russian Federation)
- Ms. Amber Larsen, international humanitarian law (Sweden)

I have designated Ms. Bernal Moncada to serve as the Coordinator of the Panel of Experts.

A fifth expert will be appointed as soon as possible.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
